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ADVICE BOOK



During the mobility in Italy, students worked in four trans-national groups to discuss about quality education.

Afterwards, the groups shared their conclusions:

Group 1

WHAT IS YOUR IDEAL SCHOOL?

A school that promotes love for learning in both students and teachers is the ideal one. There should be plenty of opportunities for students to explore their hobbies and pursue their passions without being frightened to attend school. The curriculum should be challenging, interesting, and incorporate sports. Additionally, a method that is already used in Sweden entails taking daily walks during school hours and discussing different topics, as well as organizing trips and events for students. Using technology in our regular classroom instruction and not feeling under pressure to perform well are crucial components. Additionally, it would be nice to see more schools adopt the Montessori approach.

HOW SHOULD YOUR IDEAL SCHOOL BE ORGANISED?

An ideal school should be set up to promote learning and development. This entails using good teaching strategies, a clear and consistent curriculum, and an inviting atmosphere. Furthermore, it's critical that students have access to tools and services that can aid their success, like tutoring, counseling, and extracurricular pursuits. Additionally, the length of the school day should be cut to five hours, and after those five hours, extracurricular activities should be offered. It would also be a good idea to start the school day at nine, to allow more breaks and divide students according to their motivation and knowledge levels.

COMPARE YOUR IDEAL SCHOOL TO YOUR CURRENT SCHOOL:

Some of the key elements of a perfect school, like a demanding and interesting curriculum, enthusiastic teachers and a supportive atmosphere, may not be present in a typical school. Students may struggle to get the resources and assistance they need to reach success in their studies and they may feel distracted and unmotivated. In contrast, a perfect school puts students' needs first and gives them the tools and assistance they require to succeed. Overall improved academic results and a more motivated and involved student body may result from this.



ACCORDING TO WHAT YOU HAVE SEEN AND HAS BEEN SHOWN, WHICH COUNTRY IS CLOSER TO YOUR IDEAL SCHOOL?

According to all of the information displayed to us , we decided that the closest school to our ideal schools is the german one. German Schools provide students with a strong foundation in STEM subjects. Additionally, the German education system can help students develop practical skills and prepare for workforce. German schools are also well-funded and well-equipped. Additionally they provide emphasis on inclusivity, with a focus on providing all students with an equal opportunity to succeed.

WHAT MUST NOT BE MISSING IN ANY SCHOOL?
